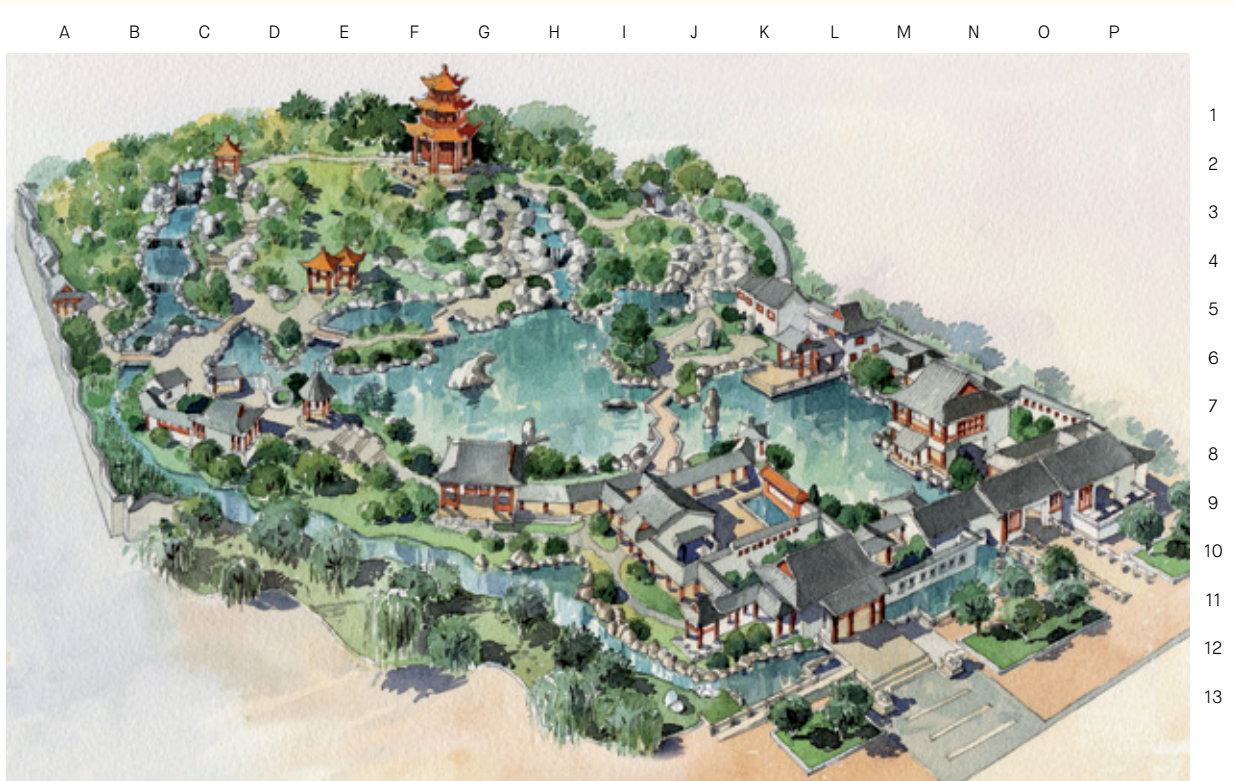

Terms and conditions

Confirmation

An event is not considered confirmed until Place Management NSW is in receipt of a holding deposit of \$110.

Payment schedule

Upon booking request approval, Place Management NSW requires the holding deposit within 24 hours. Final payment is required fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the wedding ceremony. If payment is not received, the booking may be cancelled and the deposit withheld.

Cancellation by the client

All cancellations must be in writing.

Cancellations will be subject to the following:

- For notice of cancellation outside of 6 months prior to the date of the event, 50% of the deposit will be refunded to the client.
- For notice of cancellation within 6 months prior to the date of the event, the client will forfeit the deposit.

Hours for hire

Venue hire for pavilions is for two hours only between 10am and 5pm; last booking 3pm. The pavilions may be hired for additional hours.

Essential information for clients

- Permission from Place Management NSW is required for proposed entertainment options, including music, or decorative enhancements.
- The Chinese Garden forecourt is a pedestrian precinct; no vehicles are permitted at any time.
- Paid parking is available nearby.
- Colonnades and pathways must be minimally disrupted.

Prohibited

- The use of rice, rose petals and confetti
- Bringing food and beverages into the garden
- Walking on the garden beds
- Touching the water features and pond
- Bringing pets or other animals into the garden (Assistance Dogs excepted)
- The use of candles and other naked flames
- Volume above LAmax 70B(A) and LCmax 90dB(C) on Friday and Saturday and LAmax 65 dB(A) and LCmax 85dB(C) from Sunday to Thursday
- Decorations in water features (ponds and waterfalls)
- Adjusting the lighting and water features of the garden
- Smoking
- Littering
- Dangerous goods
- Illegal substances
