NEW YEAR'S EVE DARLING HARBOUR 2023 ACCESSIBLE AREA INFORMATION


The Darling Harbour New Year's Eve Event Site will be open with managed access from 9am.

WHERE IS THE ACCESSIBLE AREA LOCATED?

The accessibility area in Cockle Bay is located on the <u>western side of the bay, in front of the</u> ICC.

The accessible area is first comes first served basis and capacity will be monitored by Security. If the area reaches capacity, customers will be directed to the steps in front of ICC Sydney.

There is also a dedicated viewing area that can be booked at Barangaroo. More information can be found here.



WHAT CAN I BRING?

Alcohol and glass are prohibited.

The accessible area has a limited amount of chairs available on the evening.

Food is for sale on site at various locations nearby, and free drinking water is also available on site.

HOW TO GET THERE:

Public Transport

Train

The closest stations are Town Hall and Central stations.

Town Hall Station

Approx. 900m

Take Druitt Street down the hill to Darling Harbour. Should the lift be out of order, signage will be in place to redirect people.

Central Station

Approx. 1.5km

Take Quay Street, straight onto the main Boulevard of Darling Harbour

Light Rail

The closest stop is Convention Centre. Approx. 200m

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Operations will cease at various times throughout the evening between Exhibition Centre and Central including stops at Paddy's Markets and Capitol Square. Please visit https://sydneylightrail.transport.nsw.gov.au with the most current information.

Car/Taxi

The accessible drop off point for the event is near the Sofitel on 'Iron Wharf Place' until **8pm** when Darling Drive road closure are put in place. Throughout the evening there is accessible pick-up points on 'Zollner Circuit, Darling Harbour'.

TOILETS:

Nearest accessible portable toilets are located at:

- Tumbalong Boulevard, near Palm Grove;
- Western side of Pyrmont Bridge
