EXPRESSION OF INTEREST & IMPORTANT PLANNING INFORMATION

Expression of Interest:

Cultural organisations are required to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) to present a Cultural Festival as part of the Placemaking NSW (PMNSW) program in Darling Harbour.

The EOI will be assessed for suitability by a panel prior to confirmation of dates and commitment of the venue by PMNSW.

Assessment, feedback and notification of confirmed dates if successful will be advised within 4 weeks of EOI closing.

Panel assessment decisions are final. Assessment decisions are not open for review or appeal.

Important Planning Information:

The planning **timeline** provided by PMNSW details important dates for payments and document submissions. A custom timeline will be sent to Cultural Festival organisers upon acceptance to the program.

The **event bond** and all PMNSW **operational costs** payable by the organiser for use of the venue will be required to be paid upfront. Please refer to the Cultural Festival Cost Estimate as a guide for when you are creating your festival budget.

Venue hire fees for Tumbalong Park are waive for Fri-Mon usage only, a maximum of 4 days. Additional venue days (including partial) are subject to availability and approval and charged at determined Price on Application rates.

Organiser Essential Requirements:

- Review the Expression of Interest (EOI) Guidelines and Cultural Festival Cost Estimate
- Complete the Expression of Interest (EOI) online form and submit supporting documents
- Nominate 3 preferred dates to hold your Cultural Festival. PMNSW will aim to support your first preferred date.
- If successful in securing a date, engage with your community to coordinate the best program of entertainment, food and culturally relevant displays to represent both modern and traditional aspects of your culture.
- Adhere to your documentation & payment timeline.
