Get here

Bus: Buses depart from a wide range of locations to Darling Harbour.*

Cycle: Riding to Darling Harbour is easy and there are bike racks in several locations (see map).

Drive: You'll find several secure car parks in and around Darling Harbour (see map).

Light rail: Just jump on the Inner West Light Rail* if you're heading to the International Convention Centre Sydney, Harbourside Shopping Centre or anywhere in between.

Taxi: You'll find several taxi ranks around the perimeter of Darling Harbour (see map).

Train: Darling Harbour is a short stroll from Town Hall Station via Market Street or Drumm Street; or jump off at Central Station and walk through Haymarket.

Via water: Captain Cook Cruises run a regular service* from Circular Quay to Darling Harbour. You can also get here by water taxi.

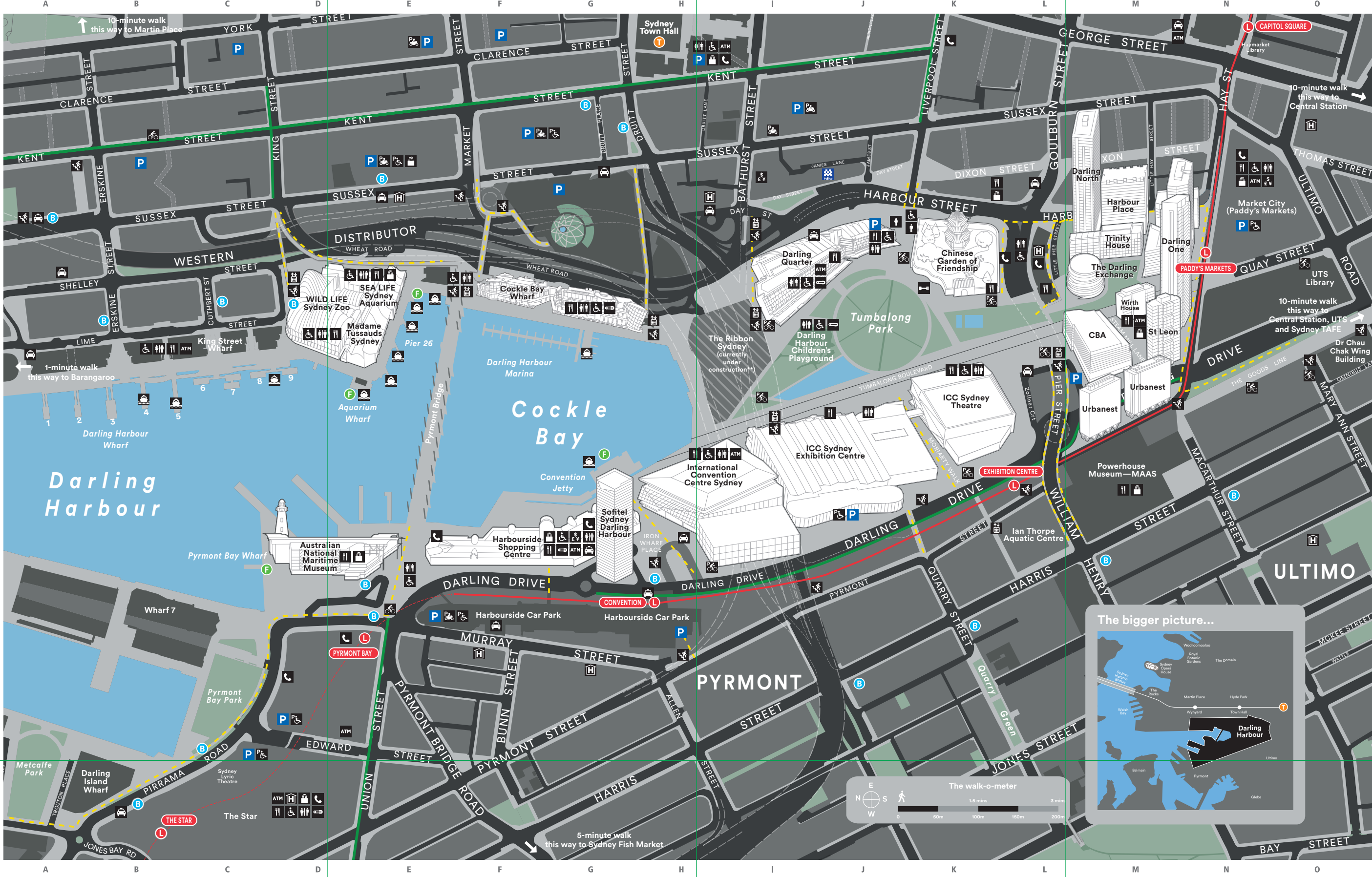
Walk: It's a 10-minute stroll to Darling Harbour from the CBD, Pyrmont, Ultimo and Haymarket.
